They had bought a year's time with one

Chowry

(Kellistown West 118 acres 9.

KILMAGLID - BALLINTRANE AND Kilbricken

All in the same area.

Chowry was shot in Kilmaglin - ~~Ballintrane~~
in 1798. Later his wife was evicted.

They moved to Ballintrane.

In 1850 or so they were evicted
from Ballintrane by Brewster - a
protestant - Minister. They bought
Kilbricken (they were given a year's
grace to vacate Ballintrane).

May Chowry - Kilbricken 1808 - 1879

Jeremiah Chowry 1828 - 1895

Patric Chowry - Ballintrane in 1825-26

had 8 acres.

Anne Chowry widow valued on 108
acres in Kilkey - (beside Kilbricken)

Landlord may have been Pittsworth
